# Appendix: Vincent van Gogh's Collection of Black-and-White Prints

This list is a reconstruction of Vincent van Gogh's collection of black-and-white prints. It has been compiled using a selection of resources. A significant number of prints are held in the collection of the Van Gogh Museum, Amsterdam (Vincent van Gogh Foundation), which has formed the basis of this appendix. Titles of works preceded by an asterisk(\*) identify these prints. The remaining prints have been identified by examing references in van Gogh's letters. These include entries where van Gogh has refered to a print by name and also where he has provided descriptions with artists' names. Hans Luijten's essay "Rummaging among my woodcuts – Van Gogh and the graphic arts" in Stolwijk, Chris, Sjraar van Heugten, Leo Jansen and Andreas Blühm (eds.), Vincent's Choice: The Musée Imaginaire of Van Gogh (Amsterdam: Van Gogh Museum, 2003) has also been valuable in identify a number of prints added to this list.

Prints mentioned by van Gogh in his letters have added to their entries the relevant letter number in *Vincent van Gogh: The Letters: The Complete Illustrated and Annotated Edition*, edited by Leo Jansen, Hans Luijten and Nienke Bakker (Brussels: Mercatorfonds, 2009).

While the number of works identified and listed is extensive this appendix is not conclusive. For example, there are many prints mentioned by description only in van Gogh's letters which makes clear identification difficult. The list of double-page illustrations is far from complete: van Gogh had a folio dedicated to these works, which has been lost and as such the only double page illustrations listed are those clearly identifiable in his correspondence. This appendix will be updated as further research identifies new works from the original collection.
